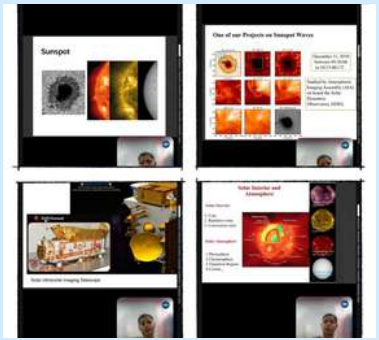

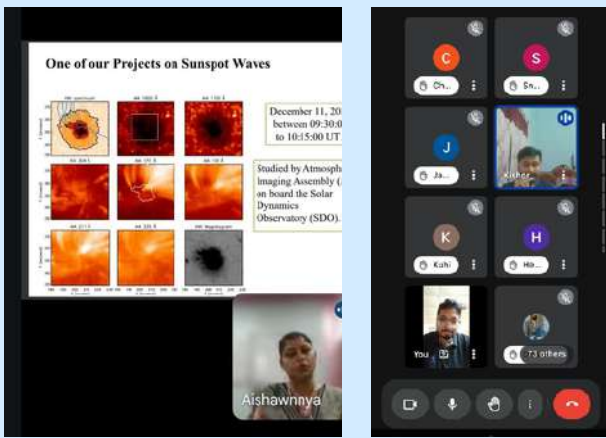

The Seminar was a resounding success, providing participants with valuable insights.



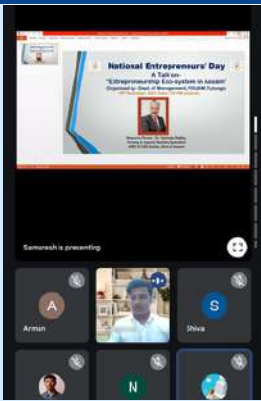

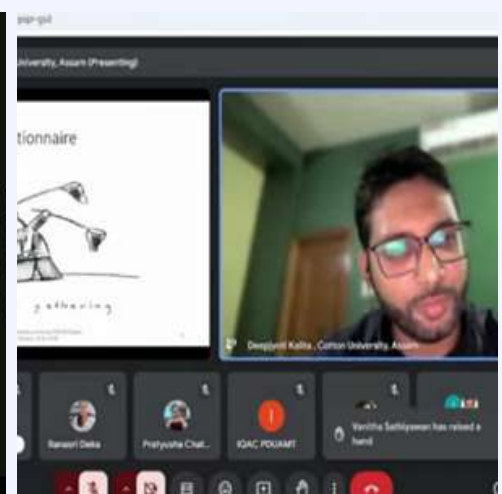
