A VISIT TO JAIPUR, RAJASTHAN:

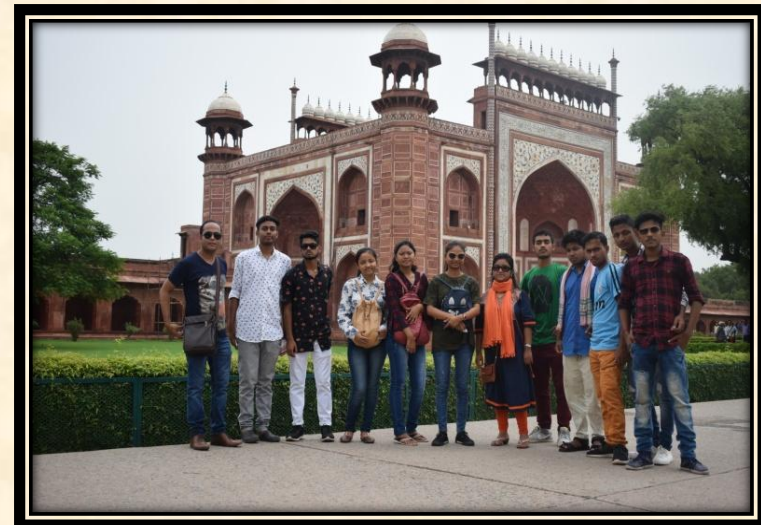

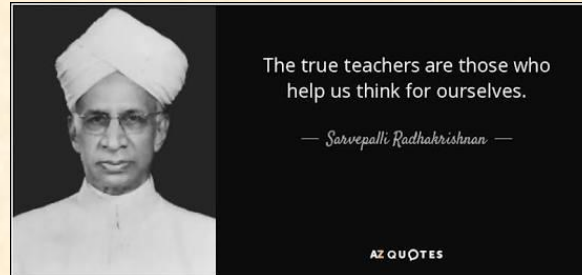

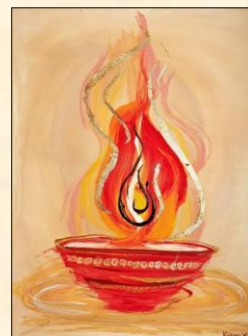
