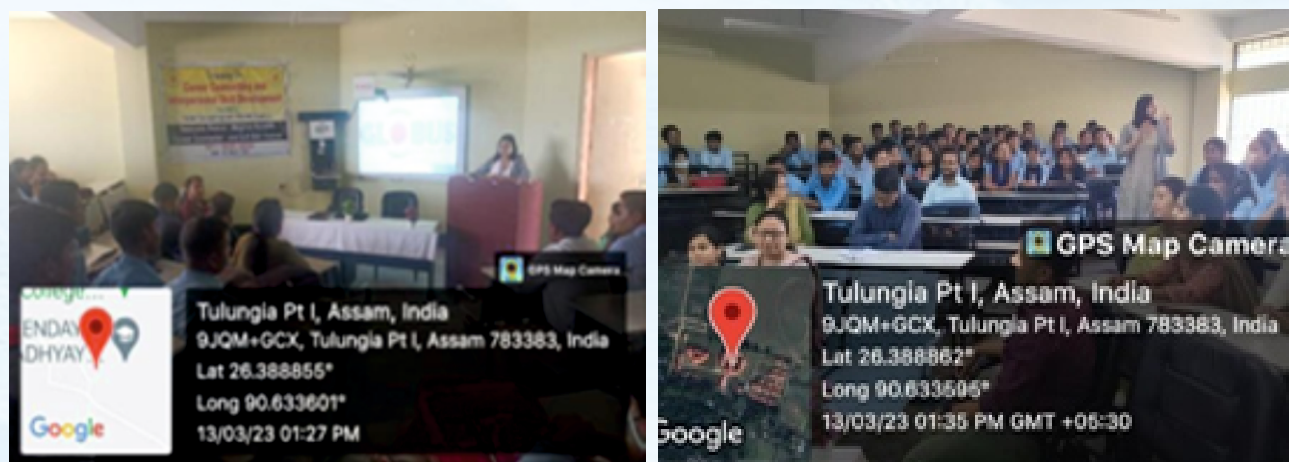

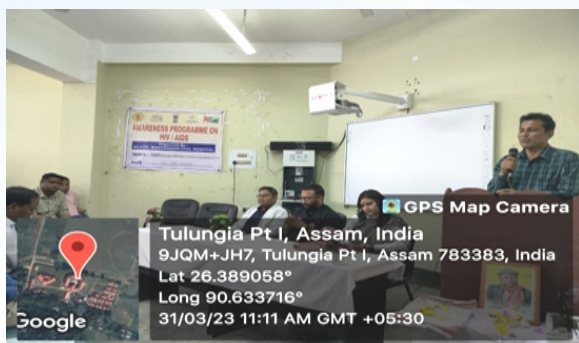

He is still hailed as “Bodofa” or father of Bodos because he raised his voice for Bodo community's rights, which he believed to be losing its culture and political rights.

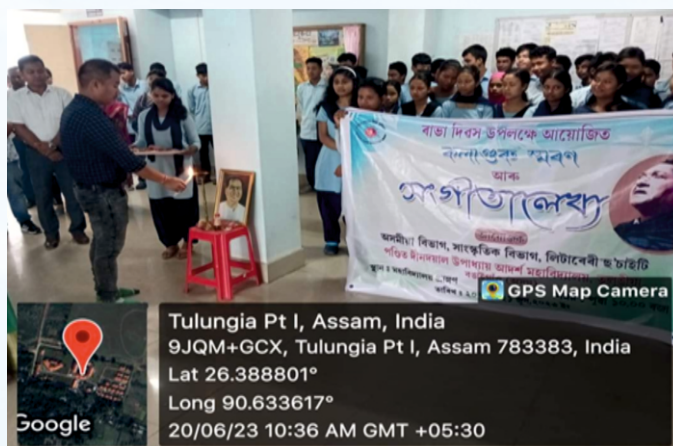
20. ONE DAY FREE HEALTH CHECK UP CUM MEDICINE DISTRIBUTION CAMP
